



PARKING CODE OF CONDUCT

**'A caring, sharing, achieving school,
putting the child at the heart of everything we do.'**

Many of our school community arrive at school by car. This code of conduct has been introduced to ensure the safety of all of us, especially the children. It should also help in the efforts of the school to improve relationships with local residents. Below are a series of points that should be observed by all people parking in the vicinity of Abbey Primary School. If someone other than yourself collects your child/children, please make them aware of this code of conduct.

All Adults will:

- Walk their child to and from school wherever possible
- Not park or drop off children on the yellow zig-zag lines outside school
- Not park in front of residents' driveways or use their driveways as turning points
- Park their car safely and courteously in a manner that will not interfere with the flow of traffic on Stuart Avenue and surrounding roads
- Avoid parking on both sides of the road thereby reducing access for other vehicles
- Avoid parking on a junction
- Wherever possible, do not park on Hanover Close
- Make sure children always dismount on to the pavement
