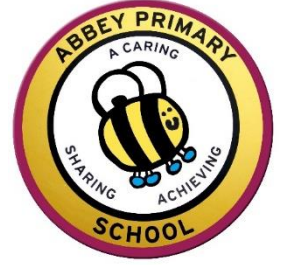

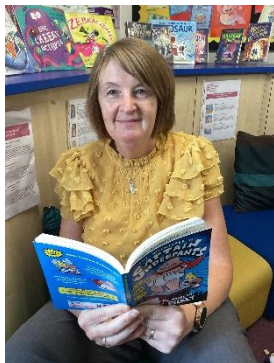

This is our class. We are very happy to meet you!



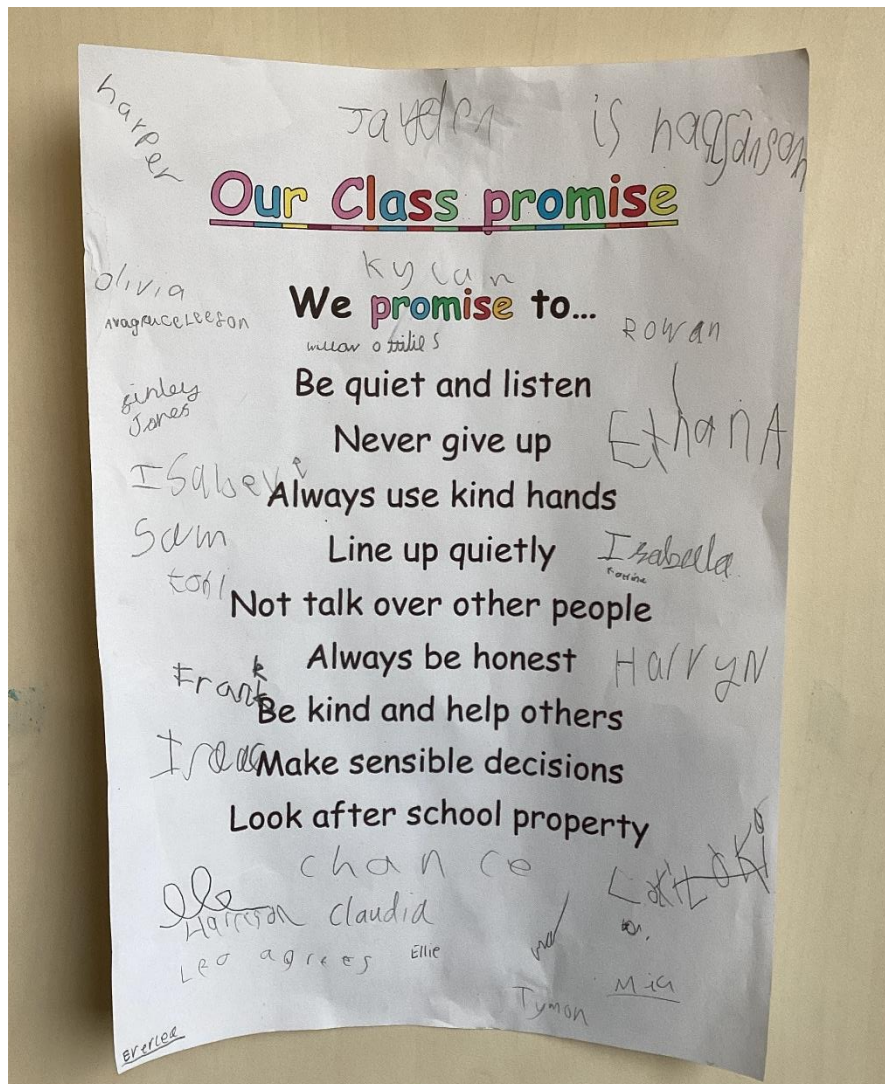
This is our classroom

We are very proud of our uniform at Abbey Primary School.

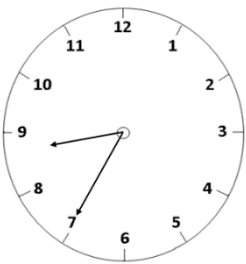


In the winter we wear, Abbey Sweatshirt or cardigan Burgundy or white polo shirt Grey trousers, skirt or dress Black school shoes

We have a learning partner. We discuss answers, share ideas and help each other when we are stuck.

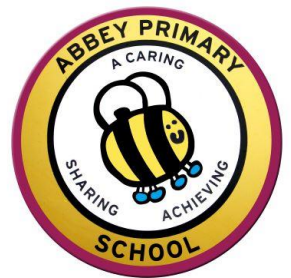
Playtime

Key Stage 1 Trim Trail Rules

1. Do not play on the trim trail before or after school.
2. Do not go underneath the equipment or hang upside down.
3. Ensure that there are a sensible number of people on each part of the trim trail at any one time (to prevent injury or breaking the equipment).
 - Small Net = 4 people on at time
 - Climbing Wall = 3 people on each side



4. Do not climb on top of (or over) the climbing wall .
5. Follow a one-way system .
6. No gymnastics, running or tig anywhere on the trim trail area.
7. Stop immediately when the whistle blows.

If your class's turn is missed due to wet weather - this is a missed session
- no rolling over will happen
