Boggle Hole Kit List

- A small backpack with a packed lunch for the first day, and a snack for the afternoon
- A water bottle
- Pocket money for the shop – in a labelled envelope to hand to Miss Coleman – no more than £10 in total.
- High wellies are essential for most activities.
- Waterproof jacket (and trousers if possible)
- Woolly hat and gloves
- Layers of clothes (thermals, t-shirts, vests, sweatshirts, fleece, tracksuit bottoms etc.
- NO DESIGNER LABELS OR BEST CLOTHES (the older the clothes the better as they will get wet, sandy and muddy.)
- Underwear and socks for the time away plus a couple of spares.
- Sunhat and suncream for sunny days (fingers crossed)
- A pair of indoor trainers / pumps etc
- Pyjamas and slippers
- Stripy t-shirt / pirate outfit for pirate party
- A carrier bag to put dirty clothes in
- Small towel
- Toiletries

The weather can change very quickly ... from sunny to rainy, to windy, to hail and back to sunny within 5 minutes! BE PREPARED!

What to do next...

- Ensure EV4 forms are fully completed and returned to Mrs Savage and Miss Coleman by Monday 16th March 2026 (include as much information as possible: medical, travel sickness, allergies, hay fever, date of last tetanus etc.)
- All medication must be clearly labelled with the children's names.
- Any last-minute changes to medication needs to be passed on to Mrs Warren first thing on Monday morning. This includes new medication or medication no longer required. Any unexplained medication cannot come with us and will not be able to be administered.
- Include as many contact numbers as possible and again let us know of any changes.
- Inform Mrs Savage and Miss Coleman of any dietary requirements prior to the visit.
